Inspired by the runabouts of the 50s and 60s, Seol is the very first Franck Roy motorboat. Designed for "pleasure" navigation, it is ideal for day trips and water skiing.

It varnished solid mahogany deck with dark gunwales and lighter battens make this boat a real gem.



Born from the collaboration between the architects Plessis and Dilasser, this small 550 kg runabout is easily transportable on a single axle trailer. Two people are enough for launching thanks to the articulated drawbar and the winch placed on the trailer.
